Annual Report of Examination 2018-2019

All examination related work of the college is done with software support provided by M/S Rovan Software Solutions Ltd.

There were 16 UG programmes and 10 PG programmes for which examinations were conducted.

Semester V UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2018 (29/10/2018 to 13/11/2018). 69 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 19/12/2018 (36 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators deployed for the examination was 23. Out of 788 students who appeared for the examination 587 passed. The average pass percentage was 74.49. 91 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 17 cases.

Semester III UG (2017-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2018 (30/10/2018 to 14/11/2018). 54 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 25/01/2019 (72 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 24. Out of 832 students who appeared for the examination 533 passed. The average pass percentage was 64.06. 107 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 23 cases.

Semester I UG (2018-2021 Batch) Examinations were conducted in November 2018 (21/11/2018 to 07/01/2019). 48 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 25/02/2019 (49 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 26. Out of 878 students who appeared for the examination 531 passed. The average pass percentage was 60.48. 70 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 21 cases.

Semester III PG (2017-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in January 2019 (29/01/2019 to 08/02/2019). 35 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 15/03/2019 (35 days after the last examination). Out of 161 students who appeared for the examination 148 passed. The average pass percentage was 91.93.

Semester I PG (2018-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in January 2019 (28/01/2019 to 11/02/2019). 37 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published on

15/03/2019 (32 days after the last examination). Out of 180 students who appeared for the examination 151 passed. The average pass percentage was 83.89.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester I UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester I UG (2016-2019 Batch), Semester I UG (2017-2020 Batch), Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester III UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester V UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester V UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester I PG (2015-2017 Batch), Semester I PG (2016-2018 Batch), Semester I PG (2016-2018 Batch), Semester III PG (2015-2017 Batch), Semester III PG (2015-2017 Batch) and Semester III PG (2016-2018 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch) 17 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester I UG (2015-2018, 2016-2019 & 2017-2020 Batches) 47 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester V UG (2014-2017 Batch) 18 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester V UG (2014-2017 Batch) 24 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester I PG (2015-2017, 2016-2018 & 2017-2019 Batches) 16 sets of question papers were prepared.

Semester VI UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2019 (26/04/2019 to 13/05/2019). 61 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 28/05/2019 (15 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 23. Out of 783 students who appeared for the examination 620 passed. The average pass percentage was 79.18. 60 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 18 cases.

Semester IV UG (2017-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2019 (25/04/2019 to 10/05/2019). 54 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 27/06/2019 (48 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 24. Out of 809 students who appeared for the examination 497 passed. The average pass percentage was 61.43. 118 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 5 cases.

Semester II UG (2018-2021 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2019 (16/05/2019 to 29/05/2019). 48 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 09/07/2019 (41 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 25. Out of 864 students who appeared for the examination 503 passed. The average pass percentage was 58.22. 205 students applied for re-valuation and mark was changed in 1 case.

Semester IV PG (2017-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in July 2019 (01/07/2019 to 10/07/2019). 32 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 01/08/2019 (22 days after the last examination). Out of 160 students who appeared for the examination 152 passed. The average pass percentage was 95.00.

Semester II PG (2018-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in July 2019 (30/07/2019 to 09/08/2019). 36 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published on 30/08/2019 (21 days after the last examination). Out of 179 students who appeared for the examination 157 passed. The average pass percentage was 87.71.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester II UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester II UG (2016-2019 Batch), Semester II UG (2017-2020 Batch), Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester IV UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester VI UG (2016-2019 Batch), Semester VI UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester VI UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester II PG (2015-2017 Batch), Semester II PG (2016-2018 Batch), Semester IV PG (2015-2017 Batch) and Semester IV PG (2016-2018 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch) 15 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester II UG (2015-2018, 2016-2019 & 2017-2020 Batches) 46 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester VI UG (2014-2017 Batch) 16 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester VI UG (2014-2017 Batch) 20 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester II PG (2015-2017, 2016-2018 & 2017-2019 Batches) 18 sets of question papers were prepared.

The results of all programmes for the year 2018-2019 are attached herewith.

Consolidated mark lists for UG students of 2016-2019 and PG students of 2017-2019 were generated by the system.
