REPORT ON REGULAR ACTIVITY 2017-18

May 22, 2017: College Farm Land Preparation

The NSS volunteers cleaned and prepared the plantain field and planted plantain saplings. They also prepared the seed-trays. More than 100 volunteers participated in the activity.

June 05, 2017: World Environment Day

The NSS volunteers celebrated the World Environment Day by collecting, planting and distributing fruit plant saplings. They have collected a total of 132 sapling of fruit plants of different varieties. They planted near about 50 saplings in the campus. The remaining saplings were distributed among the students and staff of the college.

June 16, 2017: NEEM GREEN KERALA PROJECT

40 neem sapling were planted in the college campus by NSS volunteers. It was under the supervision of the coordinators of the "NEEM GREEN KERALA PROJECT", Mr. K.P. Kannan(Retired from Children Film Society) and Prof. V. Devaki(Retired, S.N. college, Chempazhanthy). The College Principal Dr. Vincent B. Netto inaugurated the project by planting the first neem sapling.

June 30, 2017: Blood Donation Campaign

A blood donation campaign was organised under the combined coordination of NSS Zoology department of the college. A medical team from the Bishop Benziger Hospital, Kollam conducted the health screening and identified the donors. Dr. Reebu Jeorge (Pathologist) led the team. She delivered a talk on the relevance of blood donation for a healthy community. The campaign was in the Zoology lab from 10 am to 1 pm. More than 100 students participated in the camp out of which 46 donated their blood.





June 30, 2017: Campus Cleaning

A mega campus cleaning was organised in the campus under the supervision of NSS volunteers. All the students of the college were participated in the cleaning activity. The volunteers of the respective department coordinated the departmental cleaning activities. The campus and the classrooms were cleaned by through the activity.

July 19, 2017: Birds club International

Renowned film personality Sree Jayraj inaugurated Birds Club International in college campus. Sree Jayraj inaugurated the programme by planting trees in the selected location for the undisturbed zone to create the natural forest habitat. The college Pro-Manager Rev. Fr. Dr. Rolden blessed the programme by his presence and by participating in the planting activities. Department of Zoology and NSS Units actively participated in this reforestation programme by planting trees in the undisturbed zone. The charge of maintaining the zone is undertaken by NSS volunteers.





August 14, 2017: Campus Cleaning & Plastic Removal

A mega campus cleaning with a special focus on plastic removal was organised under the supervision of NSS volunteers. The whole college participated in the activity. Almost all the plastic wastes were collected and removed from the campus. The activity was started by 11 am and ended at 3.45 pm. The campus was declared as "disposable free campus" by the Principal at the end.

August 15, 2017: Independence Day Celebrations & One Day Regular Activity

The Vice-Principal of the college hoisted the national flag. The NSS volunteers honoured the flag by singing the national anthem and saluted the flag. The farming activities of the NSS volunteers started after that. They prepared near about 100 grow bags and planted the saplings already grown by them. Mainly four verities of sapling were planted which are pea, ladies finger, tomato and bitter gourd.

August 26, 2017: Cleanliness Drive at Kollam Railway Station

40 NSS volunteers participated in the cleanliness awareness programme in Kollam Railway Station. The volunteers took part in cleaning activities, pasting awareness posters and gave messages to passengers in the station. It was a programme arranged by the office of the Station Manager, Kollam Railway Station in observing "Swachhtha Pakhwada" under Swachh Bharat Initiative.

September 13, 2017: NSS P.O.s Meeting

NSS Programme Officer Mr. Ignatius J. attended the NSS Programme Officers meeting at Senate Chamber, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram.

September 22, 2017: NSS Enrolment Campaign

Enrolment campaign for enrolling the first semester students of first degree programme is organised. 140 students of first semester participated in the campaign.

23, 26 September 2017: Swachhtha Hi Seva: Cleaning Public Place- Mulankadakom Public Cemetery, Kollam.
