The first meeting of the board of studies in French was held on 21 Feb. 2015 at 10am in the PG library of the college. The meeting commenced at 10am. The members of the board of studies: Dr. Vipin Chandran (HOD, Dept of French, Mar Ivanies college) and Ms. Shobadiza John (Asst. prof, Dept of French, Sacred Heart's college, Thevara) were present. Ms. Mary Geetha (Asso. Prof, Dept of French, St. Joseph's college, Alleppey) and Mr. Somadha (Co-ordinator, Alliance Francaise, Cochin) were absent. Ms. Linda Pious John, chairperson of the board of studies in French welcomed the members and initiated the agenda of the meeting by putting forth the proposal for the revision of syllabus for the B.A/B.Sc stream. After detailed discussions, the board decided to prescribe the text-book « Connexion » by Yves Locsean and for the additional language course French for the B.A/B.Sc stream. The division of lessons for each semester was also discussed and finalised. The board decided not to revise the syllabus of B.Com stream and so it remains the same. It also decided to retain the six poems for the 3rd semester and the articles on Kerala culture and civilization for the 4th semester of the B.A/B.Sc stream. The board asserted that the course codes of the various papers have to be changed by the college.





