Annual Report of Examination 2015-2016

New scheme and syllabi were implemented for both UG and PG in 2015-2016. There were 15 UG programmes and 10 PG programmes.

Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2015 (26/10/2015 to 09/11/2015). 45 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 17/12/2015 (37 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 20. Out of 672 students who appeared for the examination 452 students passed. The average pass percentage was 67.26. 48 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 17 cases.

Semester I UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in November 2015 (13/11/2015 to 25/11/2015). 55 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 11/01/2016 (41 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 23. Out of 783 students who appeared for the examination 432 students passed. The average pass percentage was 55.17. 41 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 17 cases.

Semester III PG (2014-2016 Batch) Examinations were conducted in November 2015 (24/11/2015 to 30/11/2015). 39 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published on 11/01/2016 (36 days after the last examination). Out of 183 students who appeared for the examination 170 students passed. The average pass percentage was 92.90.

Semester I PG (2015-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in December 2015 (07/12/2015 to 16/12/2015). 37 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 25/01/2016 (39 days after the last examination). Out of 156 students who appeared for the examination 117 students passed. The average pass percentage was 75.00.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch) and Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch) 41 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch) 22 sets of question papers were prepared.

Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2016 (12/04/2016 to 28/04/2016). 44 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 17/06/2016 (49 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 19. Out of 653 students who appeared for the examination 445 students passed. The average pass percentage was 68.15. 63 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 25 cases.

Semester II UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2016 (13/04/2016 to 29/04/2016). 55 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 17/06/2016 (48 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 22. Out of 767 students who appeared for the examination 447 students passed. The average pass percentage was 58.28. 110 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 12 cases.

Semester VI PG (2014-2016 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2016 (02/05/2016 to 12/05/2016). 33 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published on 06/06/2016 (25 days after the last examination). Out of 182 students who appeared for the examination 162 students passed. The average pass percentage was 89.01.

Semester II PG (2015-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2016 (03/05/2016 to 13/05/2016). 36 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 08/07/2016 (55 days after the last examination). Out of 154 students who appeared for the examination 121 students passed. The average pass percentage was 78.57.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch) and Semester II PG (2014-2016 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch) 42 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester II PG (2014-2016 Batch) 20 sets of question papers were prepared.

The results of all programmes for the year 2015-2016 are attached herewith.

In addition to student registration, student attendance, results processing, hall tickets generation and mark lists generation, automation was done during 2015-2016 for the following items of work also:-

1. The software identified students eligible to appear for taking supplementary exam and improvement of marks.
2. Consolidated mark lists for PG students of 2014-2016 were generated by the system.

3. Tabulated Mark sheets for each student and Tabulated Results Register were generated with the help of the software.
4. Automation was used for making seating arrangements, preparing Question Paper chart and statements of answer scripts bundle.
