## Controller of Examinations

### Annual Report of Examination 2016-2017

There were 16 UG programmes and 10 PG programmes.

Semester V UG (2014-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2016 (01/11/2016 to 14/11/2016). 61 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 16/12/2016 (32 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 19. Out of 653 students who appeared for the examination 491 students passed. The average pass percentage was 75.19. 78 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 30 cases.

Semester III UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2016 (02/11/2016 to 15/11/2016). 58 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 16/12/2016 (31 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 22. Out of 751 students who appeared for the examination 492 students passed. The average pass percentage was 65.51. 38 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 16 cases.

Semester I UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in November 2016 (16/11/2016 to 25/11/2016). 61 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 27/01/2017 (62 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 25. Out of 856 students who appeared for the examination 436 students passed. The average pass percentage was 50.93. 71 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 25 cases.

Semester III PG (2015-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in December 2015 (07/12/2015 to 08/11/2016). 35 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 27/01/2017 (70 days after the last examination). Out of 150 students who appeared for the examination 125 students passed. The average pass percentage was 83.33.

Semester I PG (2016-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in December 2015 (07/12/2015 to 18/01/2017). 37 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 30/03/2017 (72 days after the last examination). Out of 161 students who appeared for the examination 133 students passed. The average pass percentage was 82.61.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester I UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch), Semester I PG (2015-2017 Batch) and III PG (2014-2016 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch) 33 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch) 43 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch) 6 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester III PG (2014-2016 Batch) 5 sets of question papers were prepared.

Semester VI UG (2014-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2017 (19/04/2017 to 28/04/2017). 55 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 31/05/2017 (32 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 19. Out of 644 students who appeared for the examination 501 students passed. The average pass percentage was 77.80. 61 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 7 cases.

Semester IV UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2017 (02/05/2017 to 16/05/2017). 57 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 21/07/2017 (65 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 22. Out of 738 students who appeared for the examination 462 students passed. The average pass percentage was 62.60. 106 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 35 cases.

Semester II UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2017 (03/05/2017 to 17/05/2017). 60 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 21/07/2017 (64 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 23. Out of 839 students who appeared for the examination 414 students passed. The average pass percentage was 49.34. 164 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 47 cases.

Semester IV PG (2015-2017 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2016 (03/05/2016 to 21/06/2017). 32 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 16/08/2017 (56 days after the last examination). Out of 147 students who appeared for the examination 125 students passed. The average pass percentage was 85.03.

Semester II PG (2016-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2016 (03/05/2016 to 21/07/2017). 36 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 19/09/2017 (59 days after the last examination). Out of 158 students who appeared for the examination 139 students passed. The average pass percentage was 87.97.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester II UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester II PG (2014-2016 Batch), Semester II PG (2015-2017 Batch) and IV PG (2014-2016 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester II UG

(2014-2017 Batch) 35 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch) 44 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester II PG (2014-2016 Batch)-5 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester IV PG (2014-2016 Batch) 7 sets of question papers were prepared.

The results of all programmes for the year 2016-2017 are attached herewith.

Consolidated mark lists for UG students of 2014-2017 and PG students of 2015-2017 were generated by the system.
