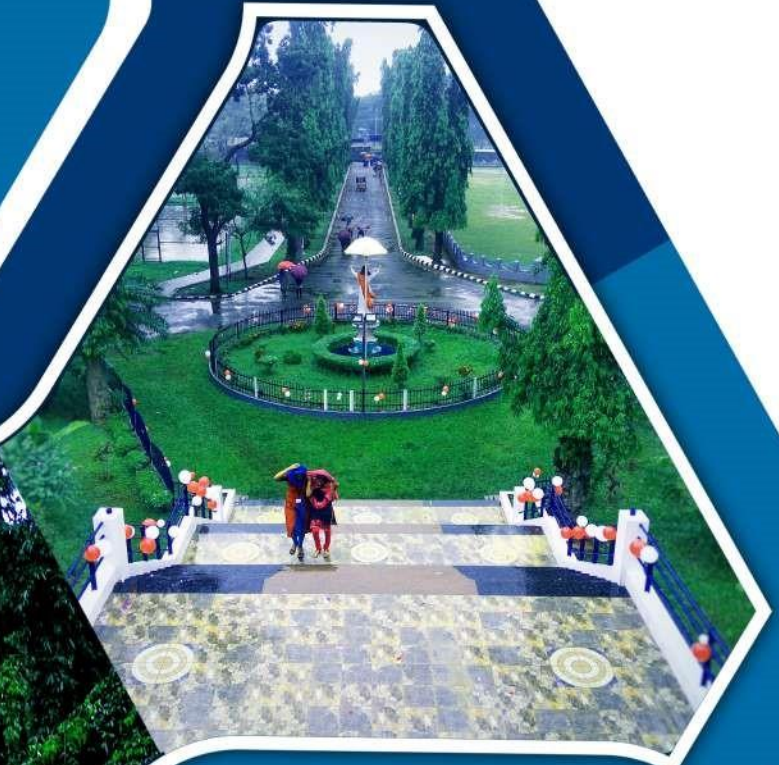

### Annual Report of Examination 2017-2018

The contract with M/s Emstem Technologies, Bangalore was over in June 2017 and we entered into a contract with M/s Rovam Software Solutions Ltd., Tamil Nadu to provide software for all examination related jobs.

In addition to performing all existing modules and functions the new software helps us in foil card generation, moderation plan, result analysis, student performance report, absentees list, malpractice cases, script summary for answer scripts bundles, and rank list.

The software is also used for preparing list of examiners and question paper setters.

There were 16 UG programmes and 10 PG programmes.

Semester V UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2017 (23/10/2017 to 06/11/2017). 68 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 21/12/2017 (45 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 21. Out of 712 students who appeared for the examination 510 students passed. The average pass percentage was 71.63. 74 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 26 cases.

Semester III UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in October 2017 (26/10/2017 to 09/11/2017). 54 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 21/12/2017 (42 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 23. Out of 801 students who appeared for the examination 552 students passed. The average pass percentage was 68.91. 104 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 33 cases.

Semester I UG (2017-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in November 2017 (20/11/2017 to 04/12/2017). 48 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 27/01/2018 (54 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 25. Out of 851 students who appeared for the examination 528 students passed. The average pass percentage was 62.04. 95 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 21 cases.

Semester III PG (2016-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in December 2017 (12/12/2017 to 21/12/2017). 35 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 08/02/2018 (49 days after the last examination). Out of 159 students who appeared for the examination 138 students passed. The average pass percentage was 86.79.

Semester I PG (2017-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in January 2018 (17/01/2018 to 27/01/2018). 37 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 27/03/2018 (59 days after the last examination). Out of 163 students who appeared for the examination 142 students passed. The average pass percentage was 87.12.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester I UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester I UG (2016-2019 Batch), Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester III UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch), Semester I PG (2015-2017 Batch), Semester I PG (2016-2018 Batch), III PG (2014-2016 Batch) and III PG (2015-2017 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester I UG (2014-2017 Batch) 25 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester III UG (2014-2017 Batch) 40 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester I PG (2014-2016 Batch) 1 set of question papers was prepared and Semester III PG (2014-2016 Batch) 1 set of question papers was prepared.

Semester VI UG (2015-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2018 (11/04/2018 to 21/04/2018). 60 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 24/05/2018 (33 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 20. Out of 698 students who appeared for the examination 555 students passed. The average pass percentage was 79.51. 92 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 41 cases.

Semester IV UG (2016-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in April 2018 (23/04/2018 to 04/05/2018). 54 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 28/06/2018 (55 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 23. Out of 790 students who appeared for the examination 534 students passed. The average pass percentage was 67.59. 83 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 25 cases.

Semester II UG (2017-2020 Batch) Examinations were conducted in May 2018 (14/05/2018 to 25/05/2018). 48 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 17/07/2018 (53 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 24. Out of 828 students who appeared for the examination 483 students passed. The average pass percentage was 58.33. 84 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed in 30 cases.

Semester IV PG (2016-2018 Batch) Examinations were conducted in July 2018 (02/07/2018 to 13/07/2018). 32 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 17/08/2018 (35 days after the last examination). Out of 154 students who appeared for the examination 136 students passed. The average pass percentage was 88.31.


Semester II PG (2017-2019 Batch) Examinations were conducted in July 2018 (25/07/2018 to 06/08/2018). 36 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 5. The results were published on 19/09/2018 (43 days after the last examination). Out of 162 students who appeared for the examination 151 students passed. The average pass percentage was 93.21.

Supplementary examinations were conducted for Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester II UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester II UG (2016-2019 Batch), Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch), Semester IV UG (2015-2018 Batch), Semester II PG (2014-2016 Batch), Semester II PG (2015-2017 Batch), Semester II PG (2016-2018 Batch), IV PG (2014-2016 Batch) and IV PG (2015-2017 Batch) students along with the regular examinations. For Semester II UG (2014-2017 Batch) 31 sets of question papers were prepared, Semester IV UG (2014-2017 Batch) 28 sets of question papers were prepared and Semester IV PG (2014-2016 Batch) 1 set of question papers was prepared.

The results of all programmes for the year 2017-2018 are attached herewith.
