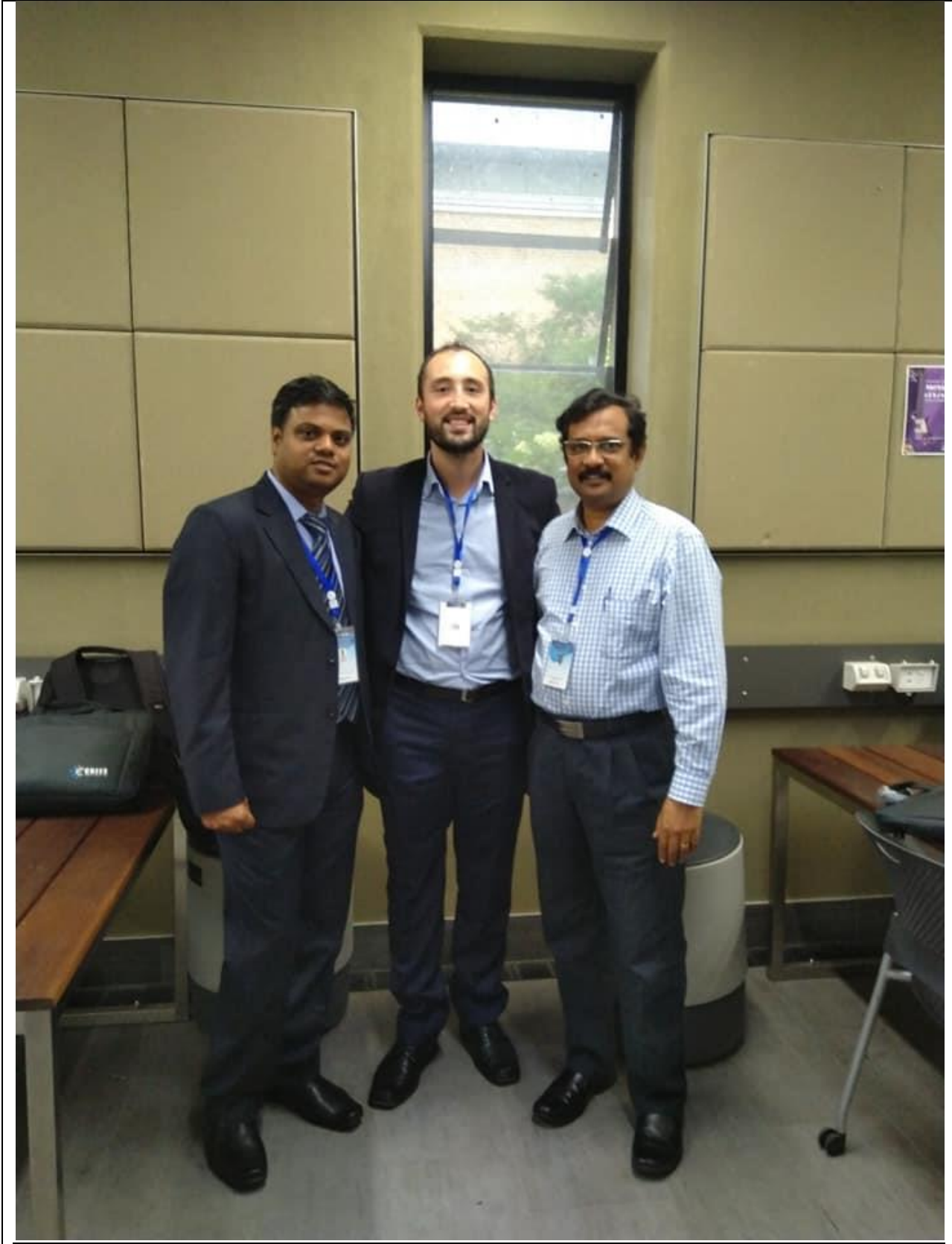

- Radon and its progeny are known potent causes of lung cancer, with a higher risk of lung cancer through chronic exposure.
- There is no known threshold concentration of radon that presents no risk.
- Even at low concentrations, chronic exposure to radon presents an increased health risk.
- Radon is the most important cause of lung cancer, accounting for 14% of all lung cancer.
- The lower the radon exposure, the lower the risk of lung cancer.





The Nobel Peace Prize for 2005

The Norwegian Nobel Committee has decided that the Nobel Peace Prize for 2005 is to be shared, in two equal parts, between the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) and its Director General, Dr. Mohamed ElBaradei, for their efforts to prevent nuclear energy from being used for military purposes and to ensure that nuclear energy for peaceful purposes is used in the safest possible way.

At a time when the threat of nuclear arms is again increasing, the Norwegian Nobel Committee wishes to underline that this threat must be met through the broadest possible international cooperation. This principle finds its clearest expression in the work of the IAEA and its Director General. In the nuclear non-proliferation regime, it is the IAEA which confirms that nuclear energy is not reserved for military purposes, and the Director General has stood out as an ardent advocate of new measures to strengthen that regime. At a time when disarmament efforts appear dislodged, when there is a danger that nuclear arms will spread both to states and to terrorist groups, and when nuclear power again appears to be playing an increasingly significant role, the IAEA's work is of crucial importance.

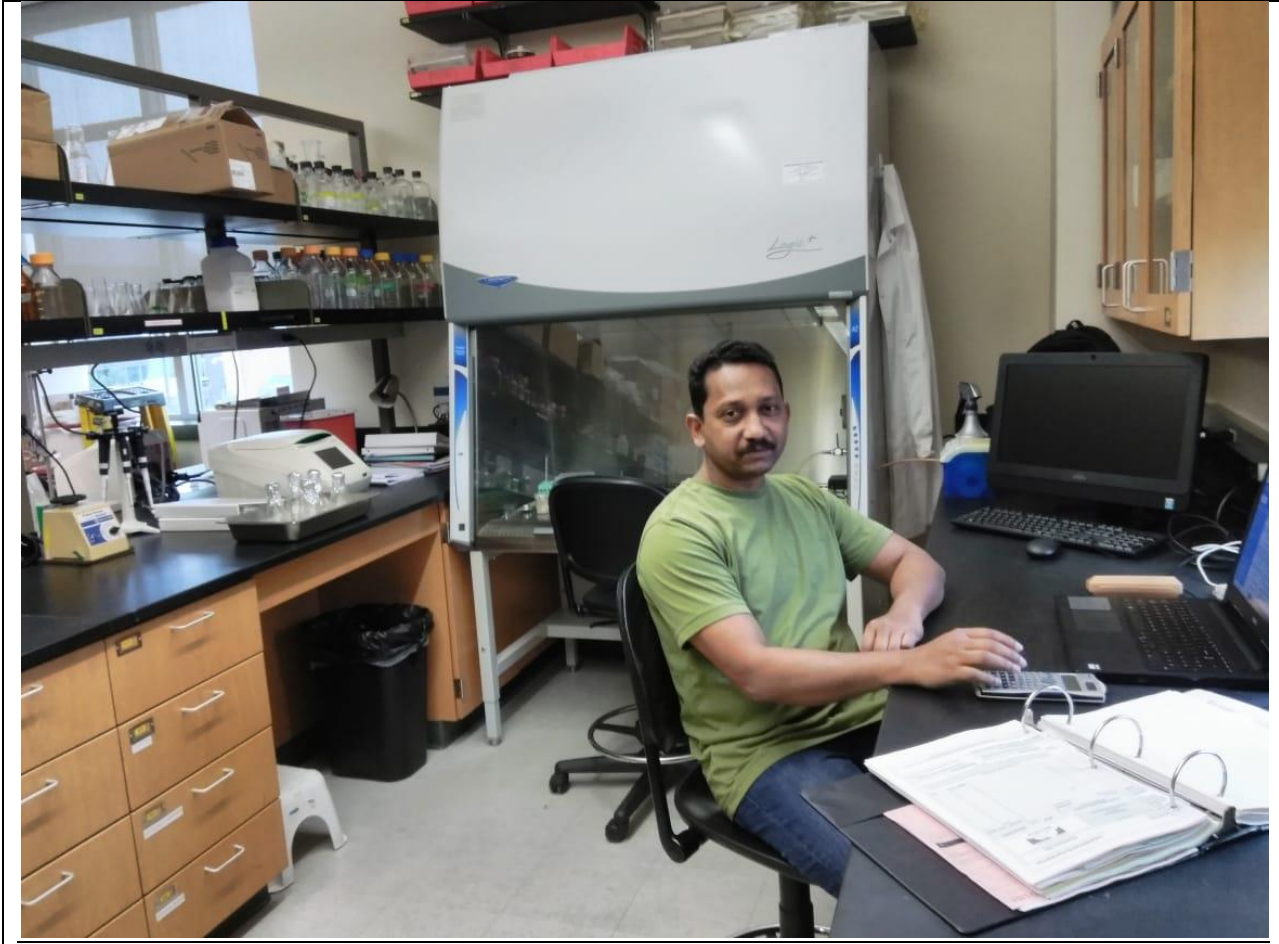
