Steps to be taken for observing the Communal Harmony Campaign and the Flag Day

The following steps are required to be taken for observance of the Communal Harmony Campaign by the institutions:

- (i) To do intensive campaigning and provide wide publicity for sensitizing the staff and students about the need for fostering communal harmony, National integration and fraternity through cultural programmes, debates, seminars, workshops, essay competitions, painting competitions etc.
- (ii) To make arrangements for circulation of fund collection boxes wooden, plastic or metallic boxes may be improvised with suitable openings to insert the donation.
- (iii) To select volunteers from amongst staff and students to station themselves at the entrance and other vantage points and go around the institution/school/office buildings on the Flag Day for distribution of flag stickers and collection of voluntary donation.
- (iv) To make suitable arrangements for proper security of collection boxes, opening them, counting the amount so collected and sending to NFCH.
- (v) Remittance of funds so collected should be made through Demand Drafts/cheque to the Secretary, National Foundation for Communal Harmony, 9th floor, 'C' Wing,LokNayakBhawan, Khan Market, New Delhi-110003.
- (vi) Bank Draft should be sent through registered/ordinary post and **not** by courier. Alternatively donation can also be made by direct bank transfer from anywhere in India, utilizing the following information:

he National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) is an autonomous organization with the Ministry of Home Affairs. It was registered on the 19th February 1992 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. The Foundation has two main bodies to carry out the objects set out for the Foundation, namely, the Governing Council and the Executive Council. While the Governing Council formulates overall policies, the Executive Council is responsible for the management and administration of the Foundation. The Governing Council has 25 members with the Union Home Minister as its Chairman. The Executive Council has eight members, with the Union Home Secretary as its Chairman. The Secretary of the Foundation is the Principal Executive Officer.

The major activity of the Foundation is to implement programmes and projects for the effective rehabilitation of child victims of communal, caste, ethnic, terrorist and any other form of violence / clashes which fractured social harmony. The emphasis remains on providing assistance to such children for their education and promoting communal harmony and National integration through various kinds of promotional activities.

The Foundation also undertakes activities which highlight and strengthen the bonds of unity and affinity between different religious and other groups in the country and encourage activities which promote belief in the principles of non-violence in resolving disputes between different religious and other groups in society. The Foundation has instituted awards for outstanding contributions to the cause of caste, ethnic and communal harmony and National integration.

The Foundation organizes programmes in cooperation with the Central Government, State Governments, Union Territory Administrations,

PSUs, PSEs and Voluntary Organizations / Non-governmental Organizations and other bodies to promote the objectives of the Foundation such as organizing awareness programmes, debates, conferences, seminars, workshops, rallies, painting, poster and essay writing competitions, music and cultural programmes, kavi sammelan, mushaira, inter-community and inter-faith interactions / get-togethers on important festivals / occasions etc. The Foundation approaches reputed Universities, Governmental organizations, VOs / NGOs to undertake new initiatives to promote the theme of communal harmony and National integration amongst various segments of the society.

Programmes of NFCH

- Project 'Assist';
- Project 'Recognition' (i.e. The National Communal Harmony Awards);
- Project 'Extension Activities' (i.e. 'Reach', 'Interfaith-Interaction',
- 'Partnership' and 'Cause Partnership');
- Project 'Research' & 'Publications';
- Communal Harmony Campaign Week & Flag Day; and
- Volunteers for Peace & Harmony.

Project 'Assist' is the Flagship scheme of the Foundation which has provision of providing financial assistance to the children rendered orphan or destitute in various communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence for their care and education.

- As on 31.03.2017, 12123 children were covered under Project Assist in the country since inception of the Foundation in the year 1992.
- A sum of Rs.7.0 Crores was released as assistance to 4841 (442 Fresh + 4399 Renewal) children during 2016-17.
