Annual Report of Examination

2014-2015

Our College became autonomous in September 2014 and we started conducting examinations from November 2014. For students admitted in 2014 (both UG and PG), the schemes and syllabi of the University of Kerala were followed as per directives from the University and the Government of Kerala. There were 12 UG programmes and 11 PG programmes.

Semester I UG Examinations were conducted in November 2014 (10/11/2014 to 24/11/2014). 43 sets of question papers were prepared. The results were published on 06/01/2015 (43 days after the last examination). The number of invigilators for the examination was 20. Out of 709 students who appeared for the examination 329 students passed. The average pass percentage was 46.40. 19 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 3 cases.

Semester II UG Examinations were conducted in April 2015 (17/04/2015 to 29/04/2015). 43 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 20. The results were published on 30/05/2015 (31 days after the last examination). Out of 697 students who appeared for the examination 377 students passed. The average pass percentage was 54.09. 37 students applied for re-valuation and marks were changed only in 12 cases.

Semester I PG Examinations for 2014-2016 Batch were conducted in January 2015 (05/01/2015 to 14/01/2015). 40 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published on 27/02/2015 (43 days after the last examination). Out of 189 students who appeared for the examination 165 students passed. The average pass percentage was 87.30.

Semester II PG Examinations were conducted in June 2015 (29/06/2015 to 08/07/2015). 39 sets of question papers were prepared. The number of invigilators for the examination was 6. The results were published in 20/08/2015 (42 days after the last examination). Out of 183 students who appeared for the examination 167 students passed. The average pass percentage was 91.26.

Though the college authorities had engaged M/s Emstem Technologies, Bangalore for college automation for both admission and examinations, it was not ready in the First Semester. So we ourselves created a program to process the result and issue the Marklists.

With the help of M/s Emstem, the student registration for examination, the generation of hall tickets, processing of results and Generation of marklists were done in Semester II.

The results of all programmes for the year 2014-2015 (I & II Semester UG and I & II Semester PG) are attached herewith.
