7(K) ARMY NCC SUB UNIT, FMN COLLEGE

The 7K Army Unit NCC of Fatima Mata National College has an enrolled strength of 53 cadets. The under graduate students from different department are eligible for selection. The NCC activity of the academic year started with the enrolment of First Year Degree students. Enrolment was on 4 - August 2017 at FMN College. Prior to the selection process, a brief overview was given to get a general idea about Army NCC. Out of 67 students who showed Interested to join NCC, 21 students were enrolled (10 SDs and 11 SWs). Cadets were selected based on good academic record, physical fitness test, interview and genuine interest to join NCC.

- ➤ Visit to training camps as detailed by NCC Unit.
- > Should be responsible for all contingent bills and schedules.





ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR SELECTION OF AND

- > Should be a permanent /regular teaching staff of the institution.
- ➤ No disciplinary/vigilance case is contemplated/ pending against the candidates.
- ➤ Both Male & Female candidates, should not be below 21 years of age or above 42 years of age as on the last date for receipt of application.
- > Should be citizen of India or Nepal.
- > Should bear a good character.
- > Should be medically fit.
- Should not be member of any communal party.
- > Should be a member of the teaching faculty.
