**NAVAL UNIT NCC REPORT 2018-19**

It is my privilege to place before you a brief report of the activities and achievements of NAVAL NCC, Fatima Mata national College, Kollam for the period 2018-2019. This report would enable us to make a self assessment of the achievements and drawbacks of the functioning of Naval Unit NCC of our college during 2018-2019.

The 3K Naval Unit NCC of Fatima Mata National College has an enrolled strength of 50 cadets. The under graduate students from different department are eligible for selection. The NCC activity of the academic year started with the enrollment of First Year Degree students. Enrollment was on 10 August 2018. Prior to the selection process, a brief overview was given to get a general idea about Naval NCC. Out of 85 students who showed interested to join NCC, 18 students were enrolled (7 SDs and 11 SWs). Cadets were selected based on good academic record, physical fitness test, swimming test, interview and genuine interest to join NCC.

The regular training programme is scheduled on Saturdays and other holidays. The permanent instructional staff (PI staff) from NCC Unit and Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of the college gives necessary training for the cadets. After the selection of first year cadets, NCC, parade started on 04 August 2018 with a total strength of 50 cadets. Cadets were given training on physical fitness, drill and service subjects. In addition to drill training, cadets were given training on NCC service subjects like, NCC Organization, leadership, health and hygiene, semaphore, boat pulling, ship modelling, firing and sailing during the Annual Training Camp (ATC) 2018.
