“Protect mother nature for future generation”

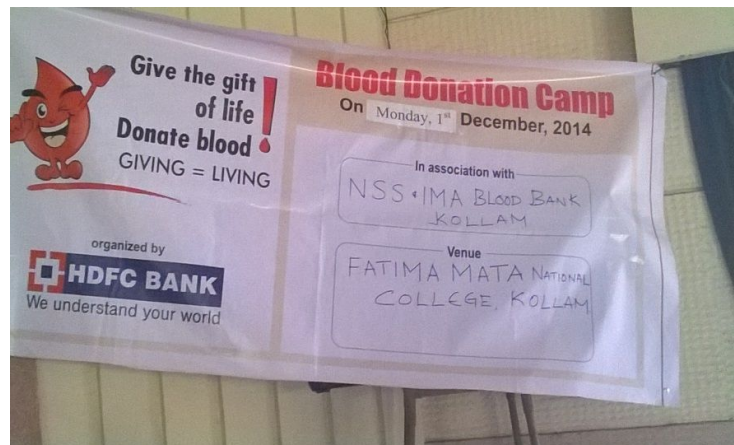
As part of the World Environment Day celebration on 5 June 2014, trees and plants were planted. A seminar was conducted on the preservation of nature and its gifts that we enjoy.

“For a New Beginning”

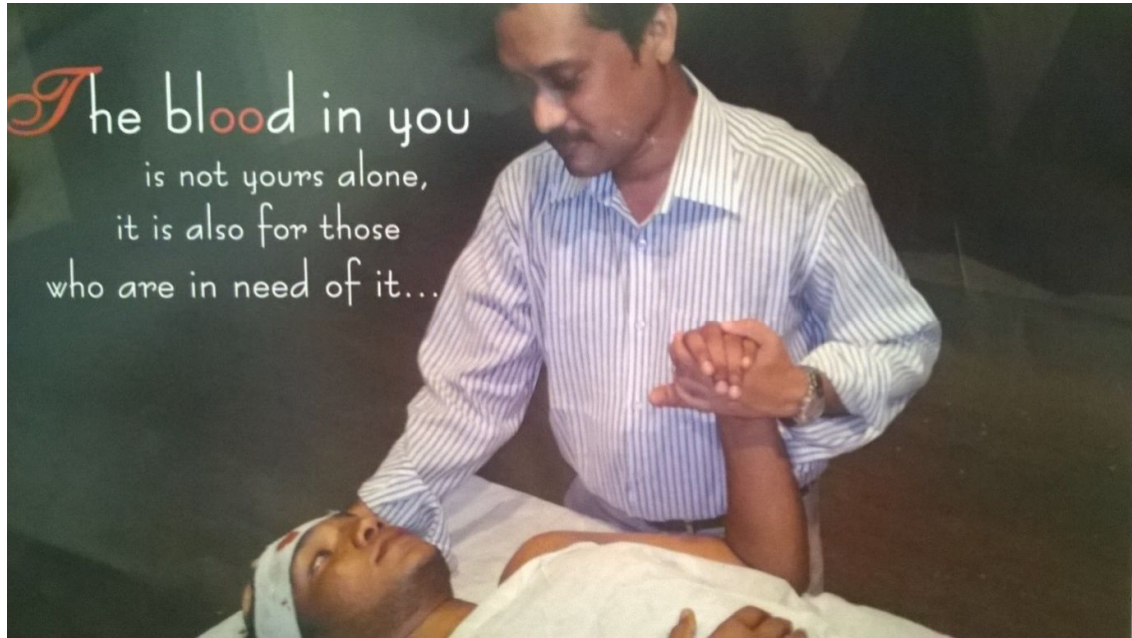
A campaign for the enrolment of first year degree students in NSS was conducted in August. A presentation on the aims of the NSS was made.

A project submitted by the college NSS unit to Krishi Bhavan, Kollam was sanctioned. Four sites were identified for vegetable cultivation. The volunteers started preparing the ground for cultivation. Seeds were sown in trays and seedlings prepared and replanted later. The ground preparation and plantation process lasted for two months. The volunteers were divided into ten groups and watering works were assigned to each group. Fertilization, application of pesticides and manure, fencing, net supporting etc. was also done.

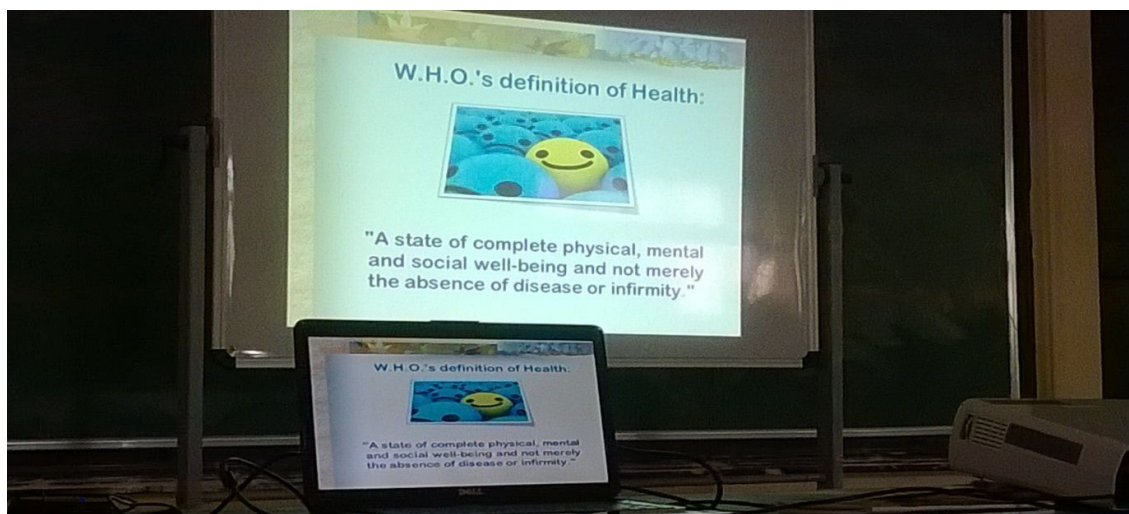


TEENS CLUB SEMINAR

NSS VEGETABLE GARDEN PROJECT

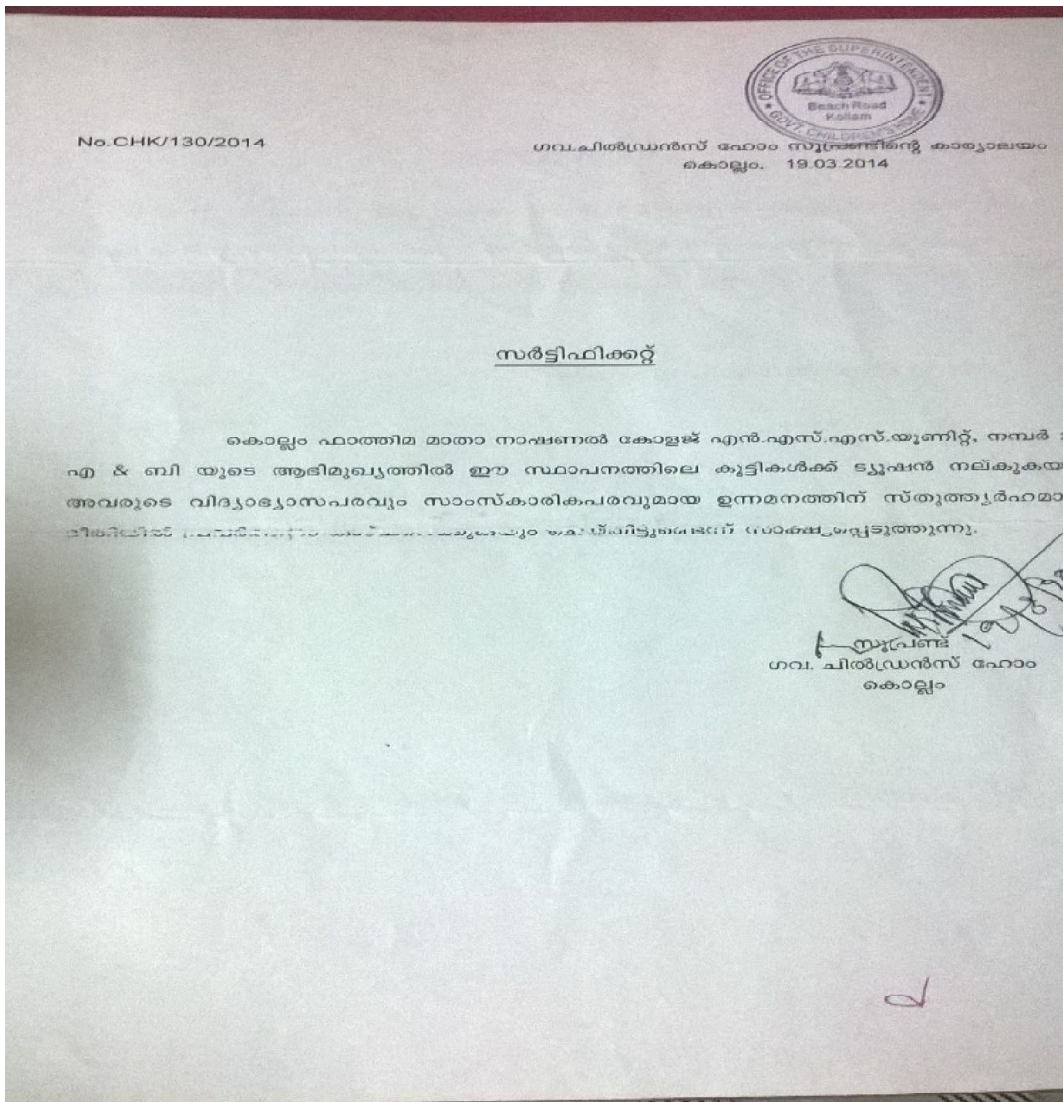
