REPORT ON EXTENSION ACTIVITIES OF PEOPLE PLANNING PROGRAM-2018-19

Over the last two decades, Kerala's experience in decentralization has been accepted globally as one of the most significant institutional reforms in public governance. Kerala adopted a big bang approach to decentralization with the launch of People's Plan Campaign on 17th August 1996. The process of decentralized planning was launched in IX Five-Year Plan, consequent to the enactment of Kerala Panchayati Raj Act (1994) and Kerala Municipality Act (1994) and the constitutional amendments. Under the X Five-Year Plan, the decentralization programme in Kerala was restructured and named "Kerala Development Plan" (KDP). In the XI Five-Year Plan period, the entire process was revamped by giving stress to the concept "People's Planning," focusing on the completion of the institutionalization of decentralized government.(Kerala Economic review, Vol I, pp 413, 2017)

The club activities began with an orientation program, where the main aim was to sensitize the students regarding the various issues of people planning program pertaining to Kerala.

The activities achieved

1. MrSiju wills, Coordinator of the program, gave an introductory class to the students regarding the origin and development of Decentralized planning in Kerala.
2. Over the course of the semester another two sessions was conducted to review the report on Kerala economic review 2017 published by Planning Board of Kerala. Chapters regarding the Decentralized planning from Kerala Economic review was also distributed as resource material.

3. The club organized a seminar “Decentralized planning in Kerala”, on 14nd March 2019. The resource person for the program was DrBiju T from Department of Commerce, Baby John Memorial Government College, Chavara, Kollam who worked as former District Mission Co-coordinator, Kerala State Poverty Eradication Mission (Kudumbashree), Kollam District. The list of students who participated in the seminar is also attached with the report.
4. A survey was conducted by each student among twenty five households to analyze the thrift habits in block /gram panchayats and Kollam Corporation.
