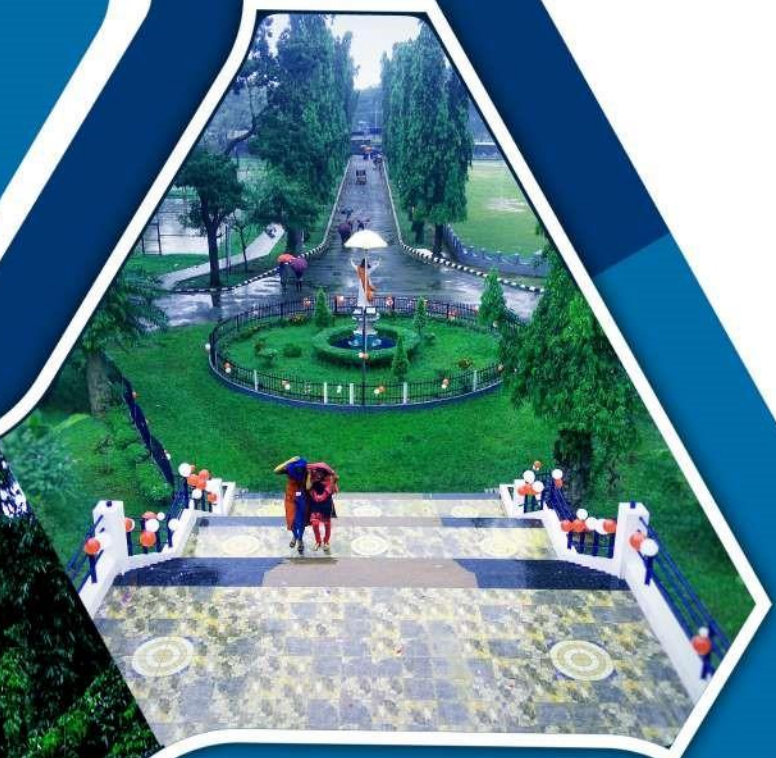

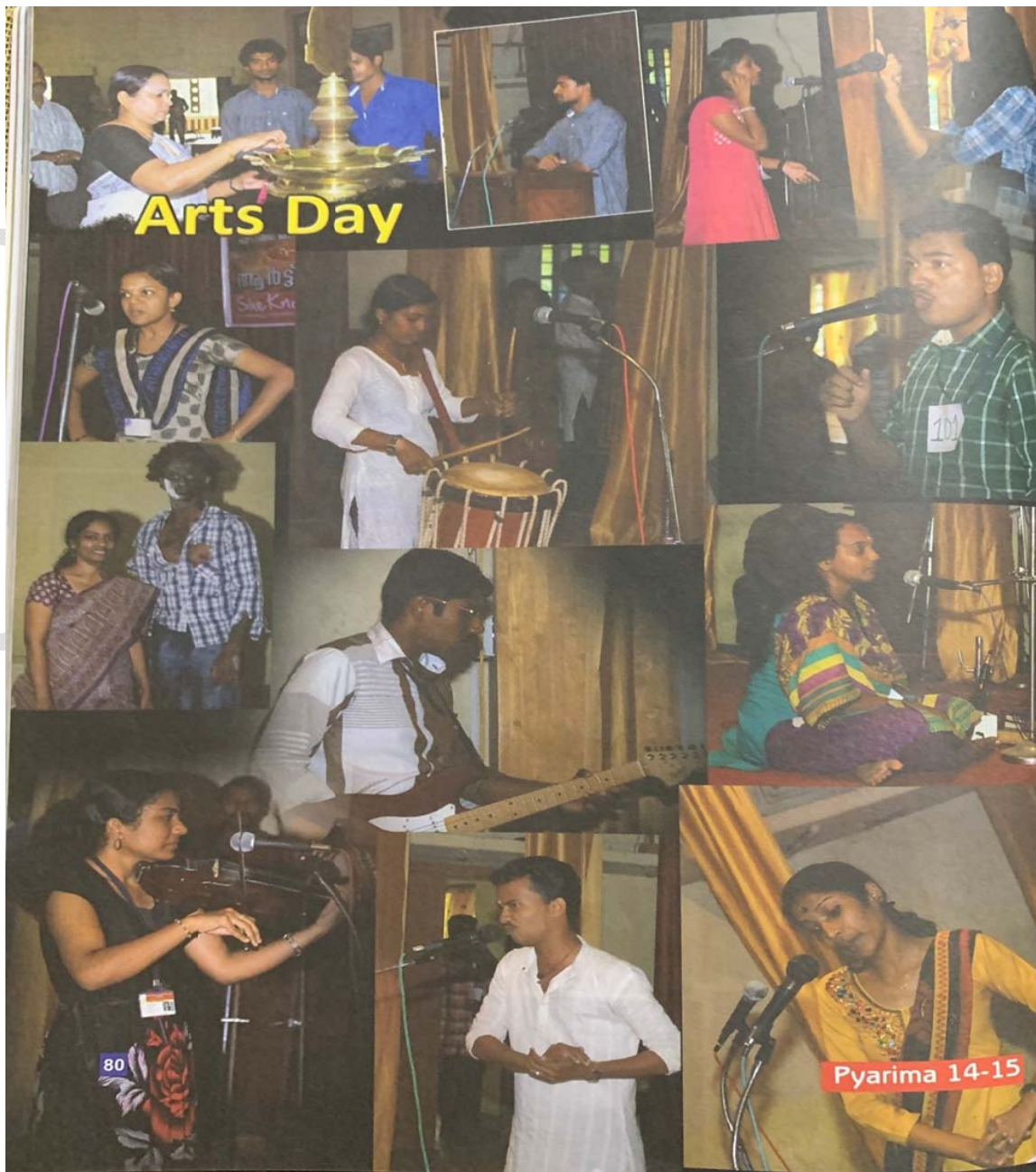
participation. Sports offer children a change from the monotony of their daily life. It is also a useful means of entertainment and physical activity for them.

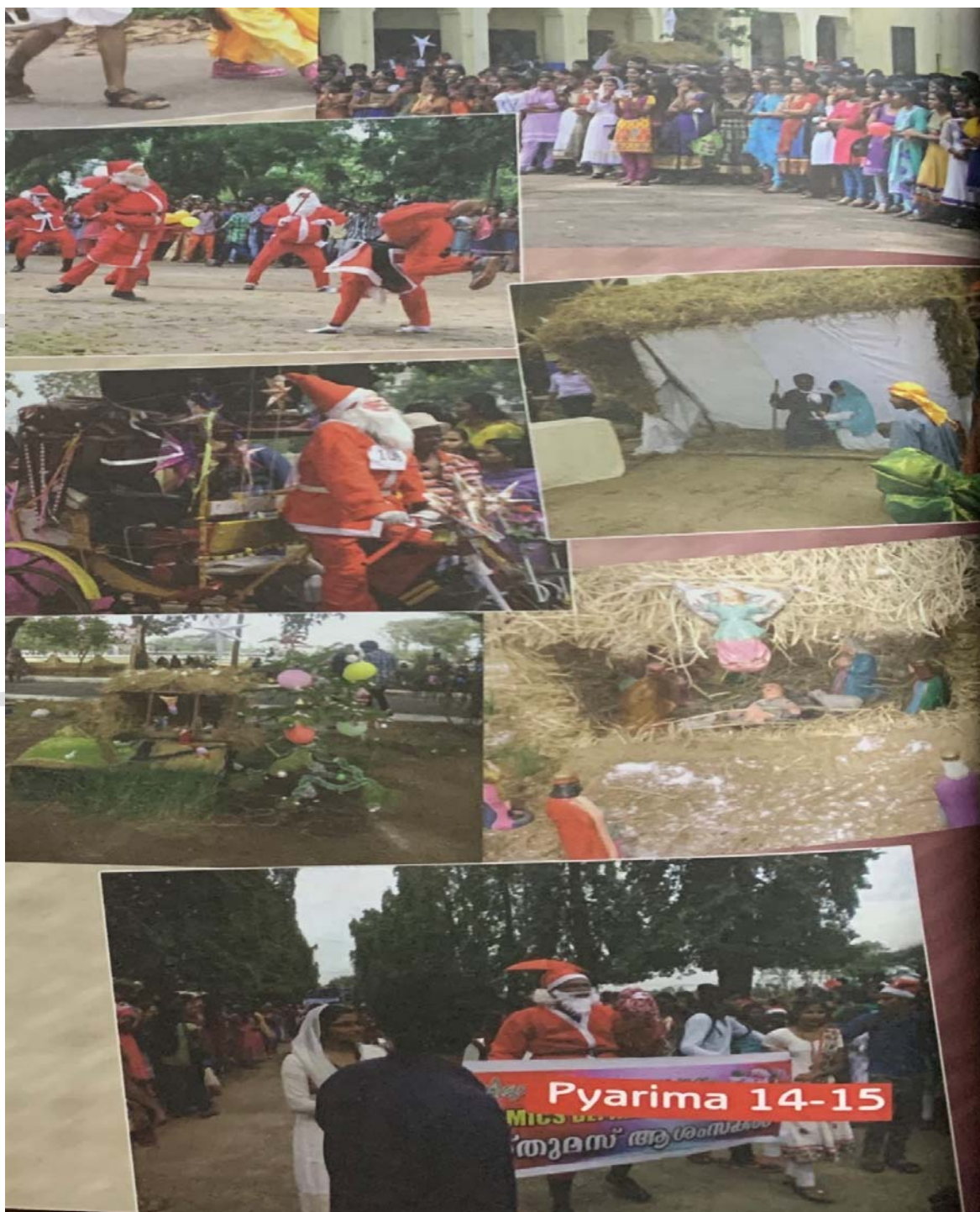


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

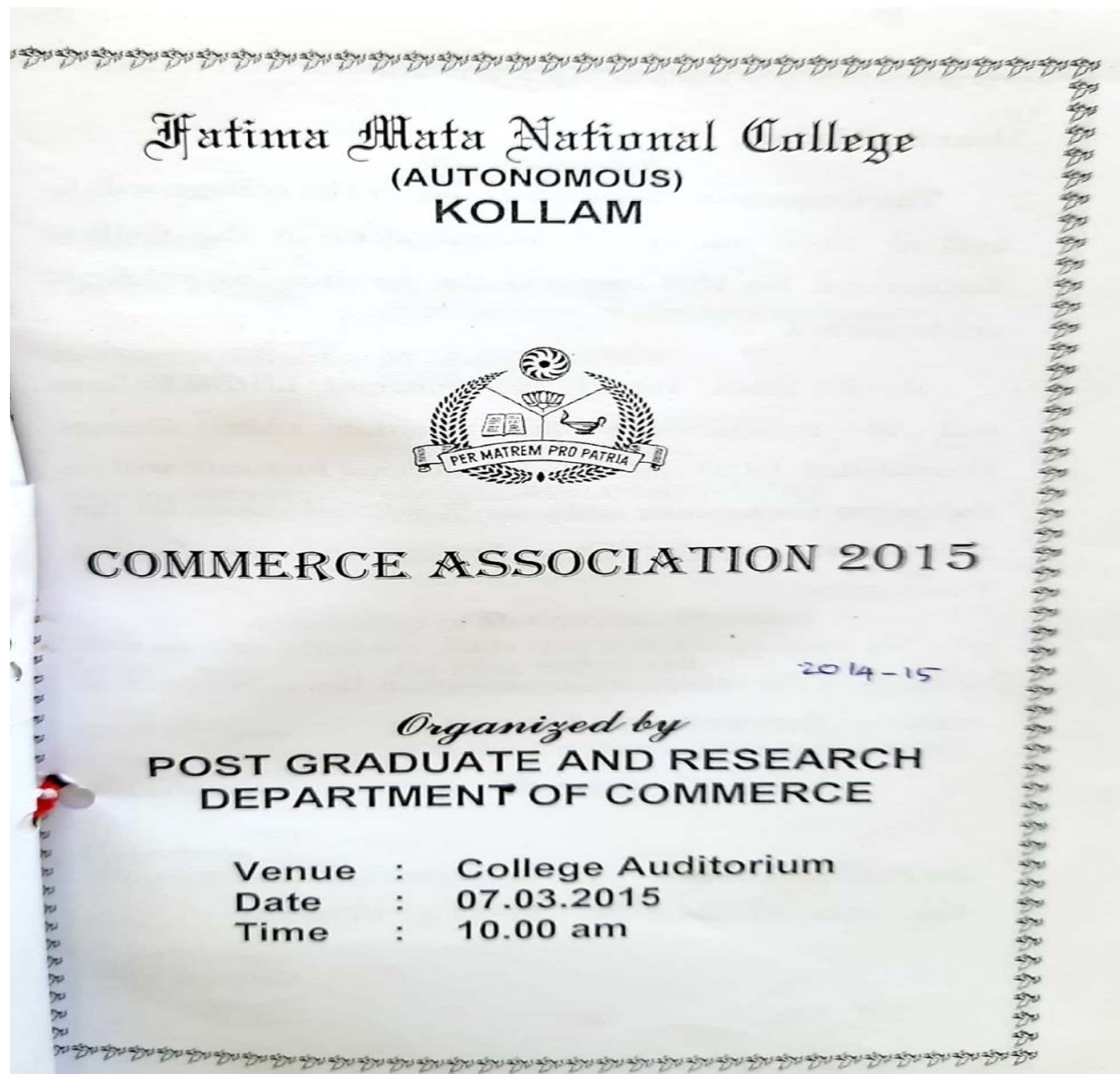


SHORT FILM FESTIVAL

LANGUAGE QUIZ COMPETITION - DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

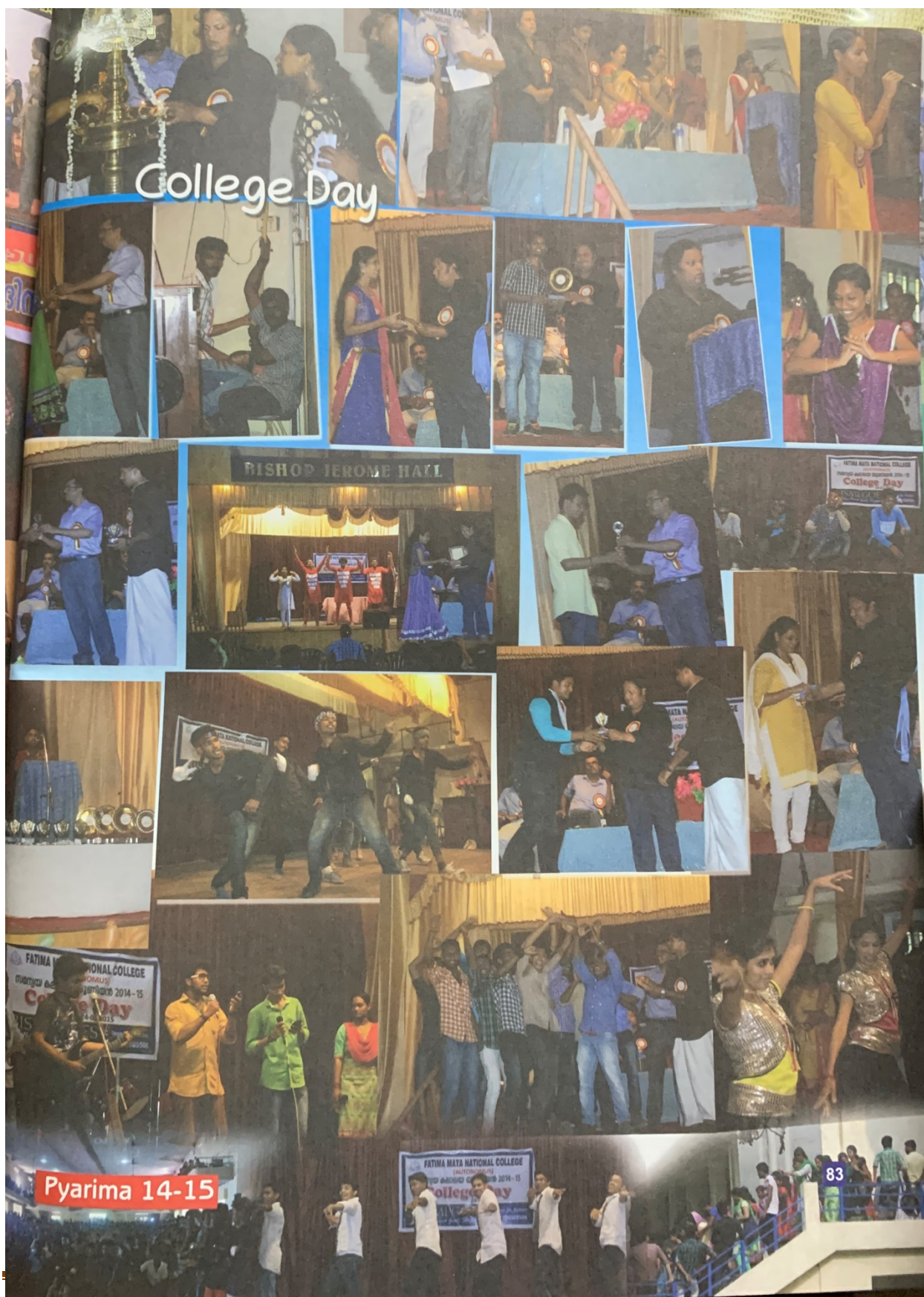
Department of English conducted inter departmental language quiz competition on 25th August 2014. The students from various department participated in the language quiz competition.

MERIT DAY

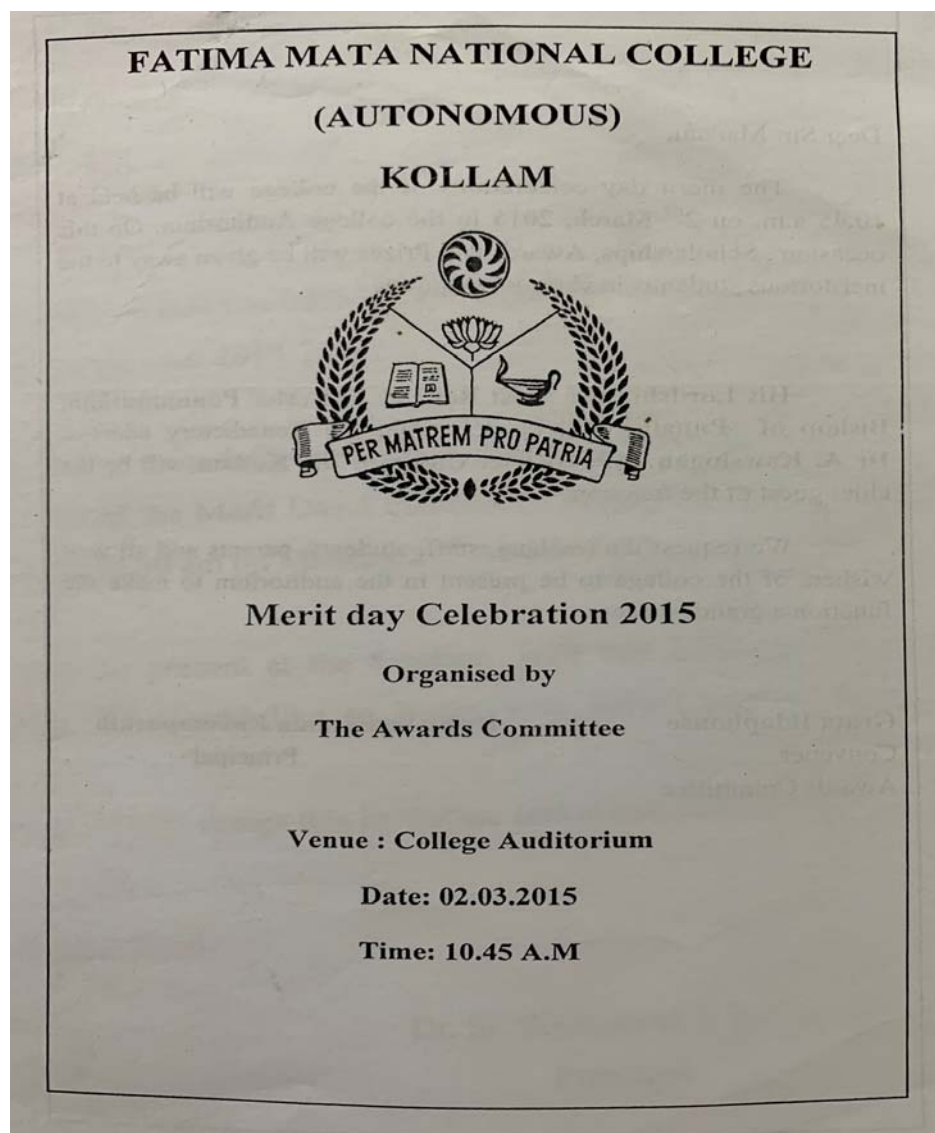
