Notification publishing the schedule of conduct of College Union Election-2017 was issued on 11.9.17

**14.9.17**

The electoral roll was published on 14.9.17 in the notice board of the college.

Altogether 120 representatives were to be elected for the classes. 100 representatives were to be elected for 50 UG classes, 2 representatives from each class, of which one representative for each class should be a girl.

20 representatives were to be elected from the 20 PG classes, one representative (either girl or boy) from each class.

### **20.9.17**

As per schedule, the date of presenting nominations for election of class representatives is 20.9.17. The list of validly nominated candidates was to be published on the same day itself.

A total of 166 candidates (including 33 candidates for self financing stream) filed their nominations to their class teacher.

After the scrutiny, 31 classes have more than 2 candidates for the place of class representative.

### **22.9.17**

The last date for withdrawal of nomination was 22.9.17

7 Students from Botany(I D.C&IIID.C), English(I D.C-Aided stream & Self financing), and Economics(III D.C) withdrew their nominations, therefore only 29 classes needed election.

Of 120 representatives to be elected from 70 classes, 67 candidates (from 43 classes--24 UG &19 PG) were elected unopposed, 53 representatives (from 27 classes --26 UG &1 PG) to be elected by polling.

**30-11-2016**

The electoral roll was published on 30-11-2016 in the notice board of the college.

Altogether 92 representatives were to be elected for 46 undergraduate classes, 2 representatives from each class of which one representative for each class should be a girl. 20 representatives are to be elected from the 20 post-graduate classes, one representative (either girl or boy) from each class.

**2-12-2016.**

As per schedule, the date of presenting nominations for election of class representatives is 2-12-2016.

The list of validly nominated candidates was to be published on the same day itself. A total of 162 candidates (including 23 candidates from Self-financing stream) filed their nominations to their class teachers.

After the scrutiny, 31 classes have more than 2 candidates for the place of class representatives.
