




Feedback 1: The programmeoffers life skills and employability


Feedback 2: The programme equip the students in qualifying competitve examinations


Feedback 3: The progression level to higher education is high


Feedback 4: Courses and contents are updated regularly


Feedback 5: Faculty is competent and knowledgeable


Feedback 6: Special care is offered for slow and advanced learners


Feedback 7: Examination and evaluation procedures are transparent and fair




Feedback 8: The college maintains strict adherence to the academic calendar


Feedback 9: The infrastructure facilities for teaching and research are excellent

Feedback Analysis

The feedback from the alumni is collected by eliciting their responses on 10 statements related to-

- 1. Prospects of the Programme
- 2. Regular updation of the courses and contents
- 3. Quality of Faculty
- Examination and Evaluation System
- 5. Adherence to the Academic Calendar
- 6. Infrastructure
- 7. Provisions for Extra-curricular activities

The first three statements developing employability skills, preparing to higher education and preparing to competitive examinational pertain to the Prospects of the Programme. The response to employability and life skill is 73.62 percent, to equipping for competitive exam 74.72 percent and 88.69 percent

equipping for progression to higher education. So in total, as per the current feedback prospects of our programme is high.

Regarding the regular updating of the syllabus the majority of the participants (79.92 %) are on the positive side.

Majority (86.5%) of the participants believe in the competence and knowledge level of faculty at FATIMA, and 74 per cent are of the opinion that special care is provided at FATIMA for both the advanced and slow learners.

A majority at 94 per cent stated that the examination and evaluation system at FATIMA is transparent and fair.

About 84.7 per cent of the alumni participated in the feedback survey are sure that FATIMA strictly adhere to the academic calendar, regarding the scheduling and implementation.

Regarding the infrastructure facilities, 75 percent agreed and 17.52 per cent is of neural opinion which should be taken care.

The extracurricular activities seems to be an area to be focussed in future, since only 56.98 percent of the participants agreed positively.

Conclusions
