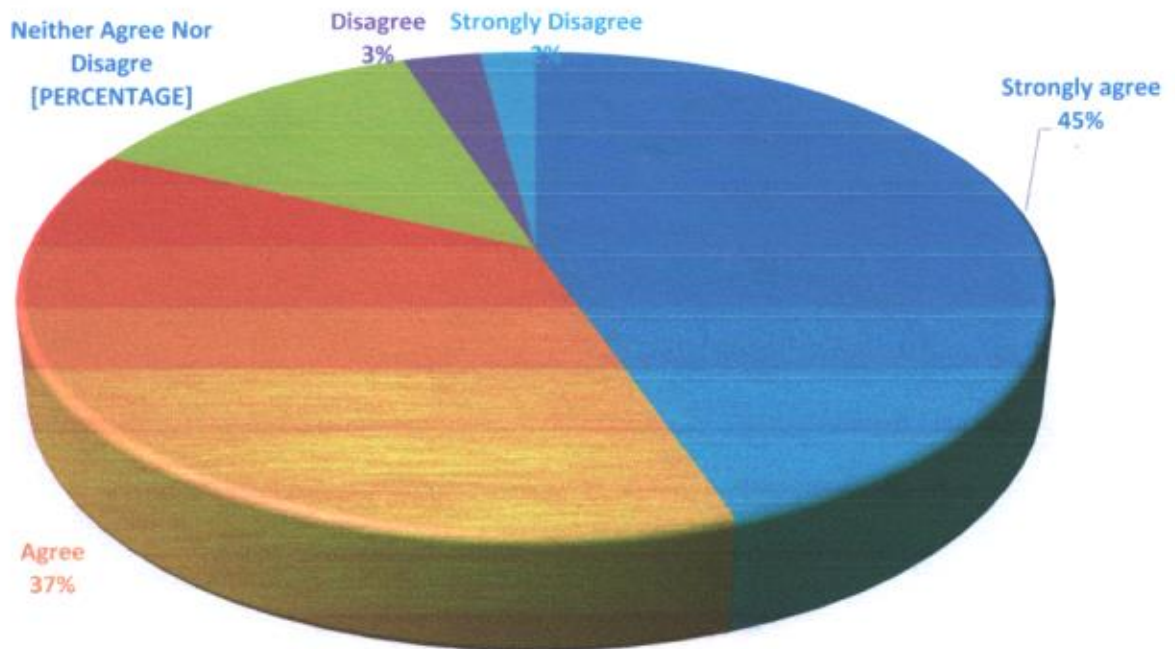

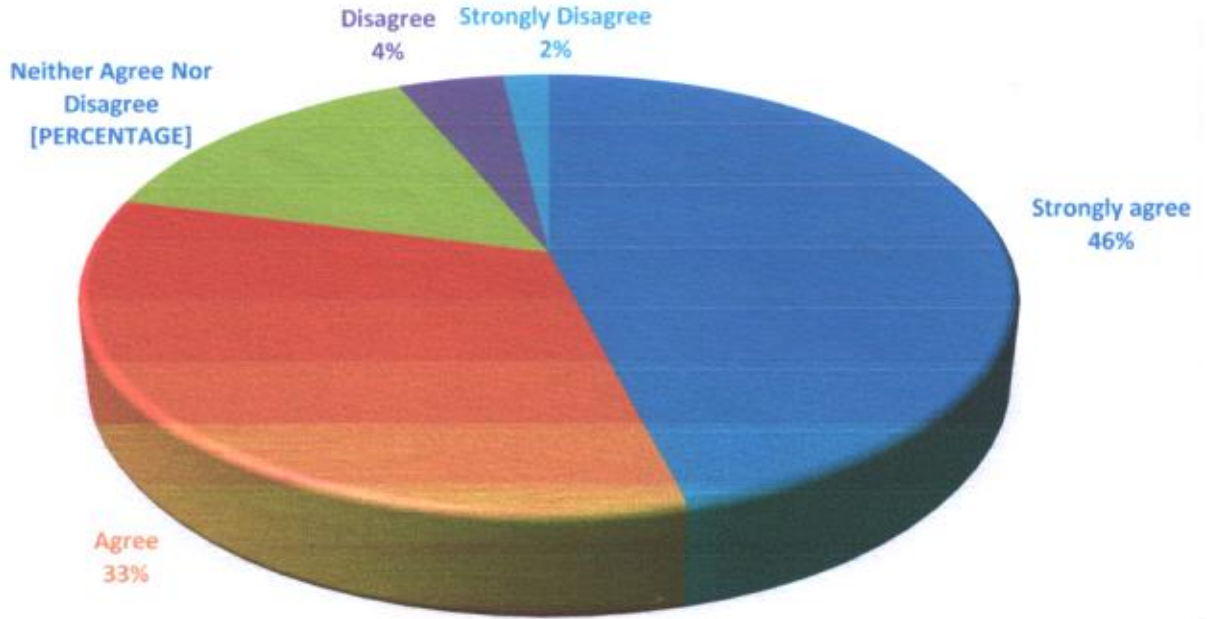
Feedback 1: The programme offers life skills and employability

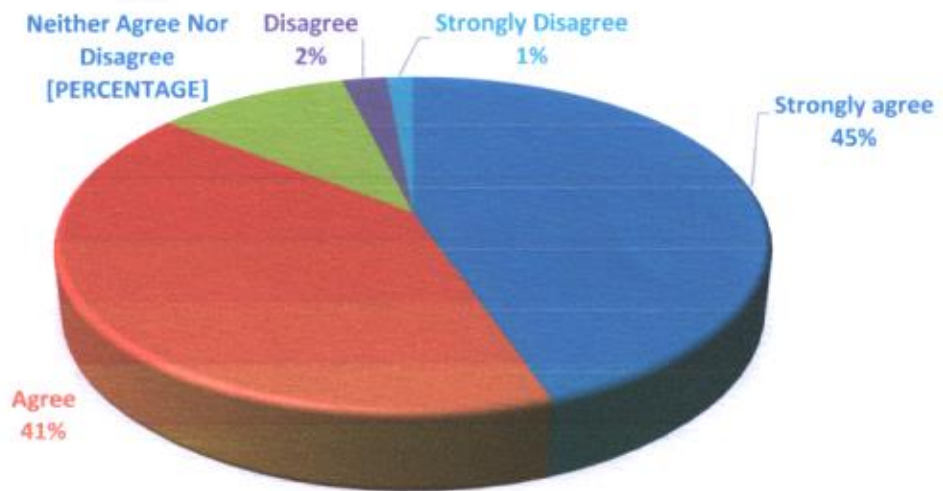
Feedback 2: The programme equip the students in qualifying competitive examinations

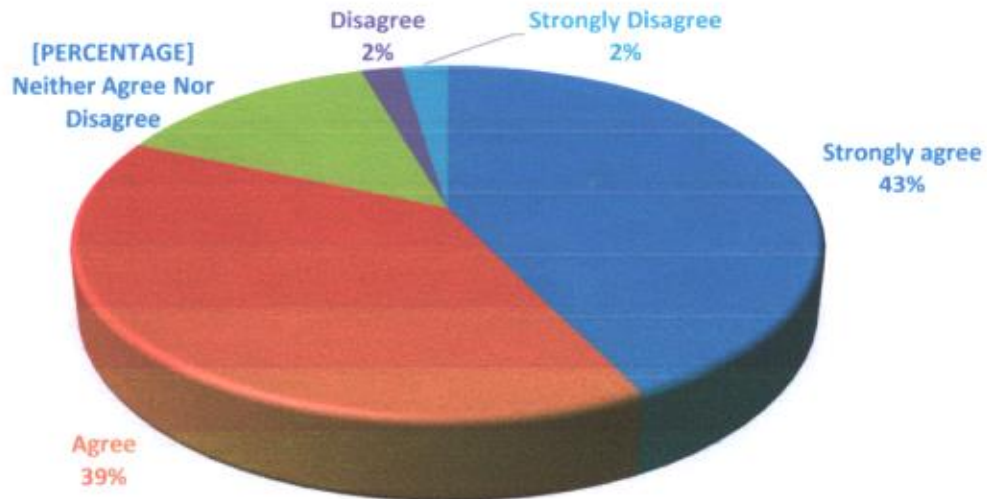
Feedback 3: The progression level to higher education is high

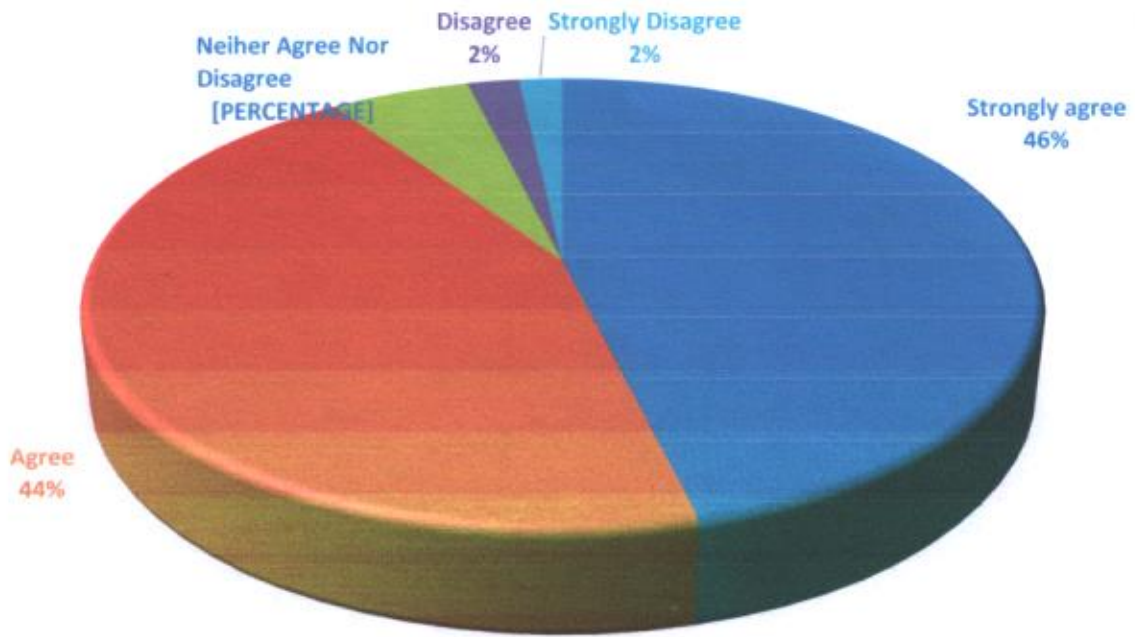
Feedback 4: Courses and contents are updated regularly

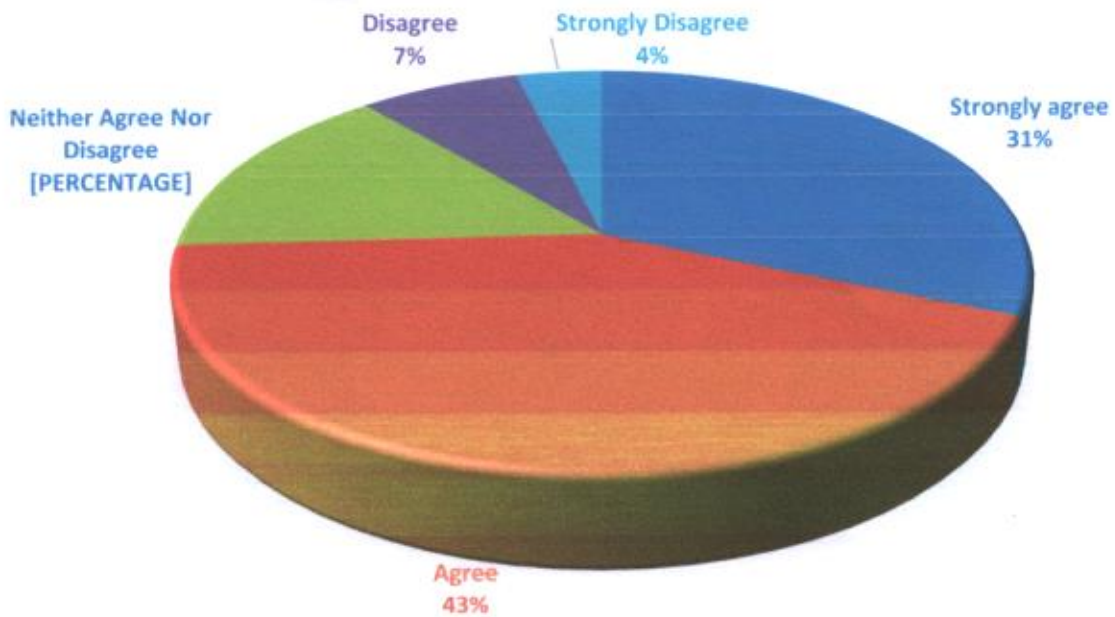
Feedback 5: Faculty is competent and knowledgeable

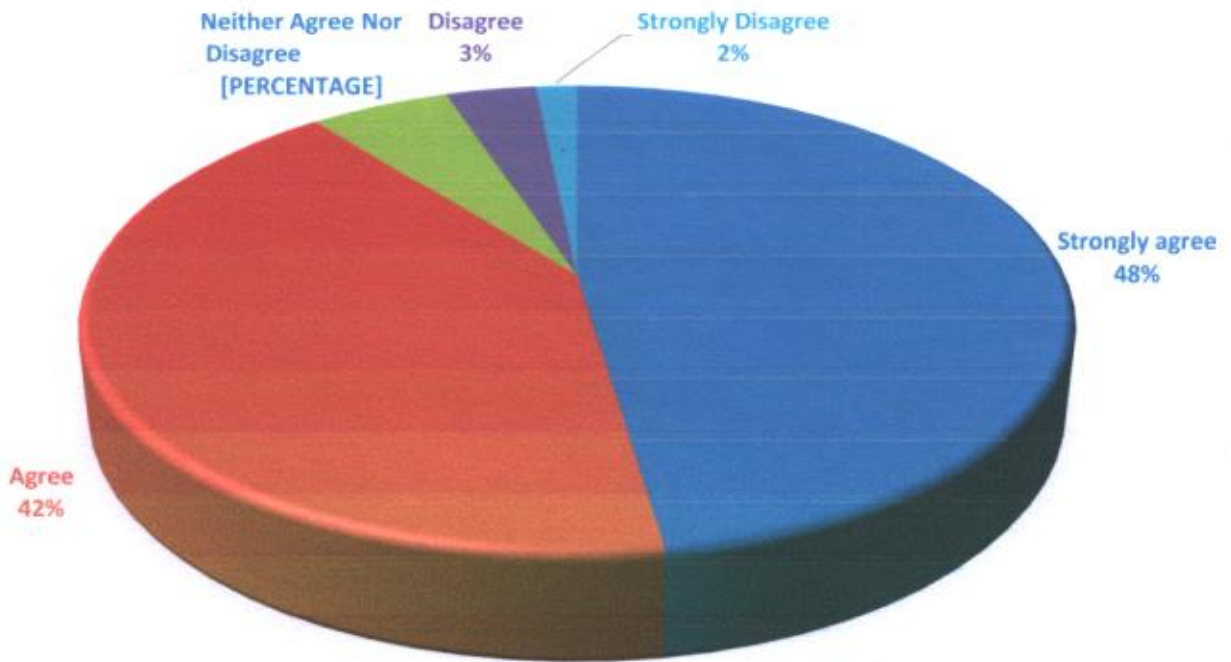
Feedback 6: Special care is offered for slow and advanced learners

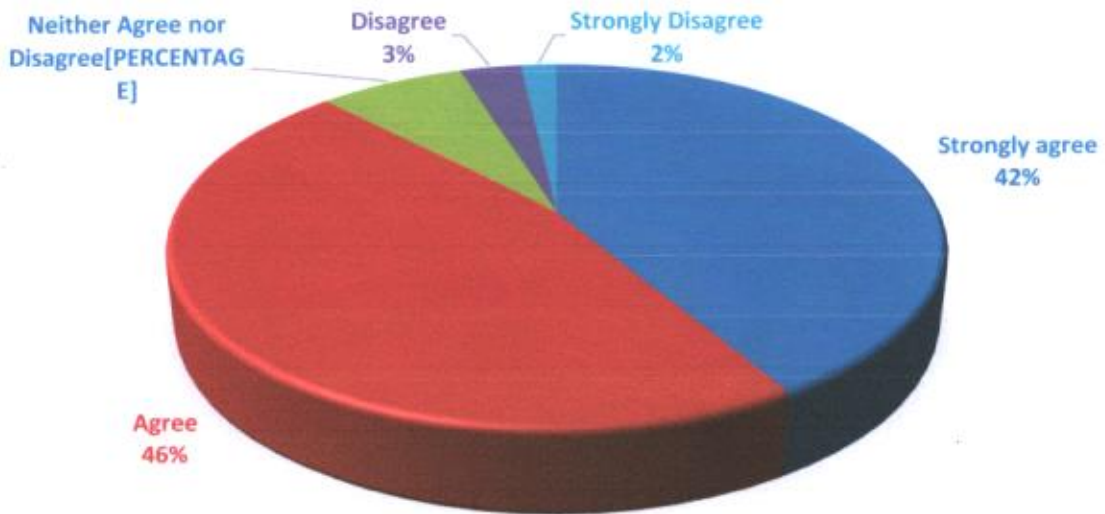
Feedback 7: Examination and evaluation procedures are transparent and fair

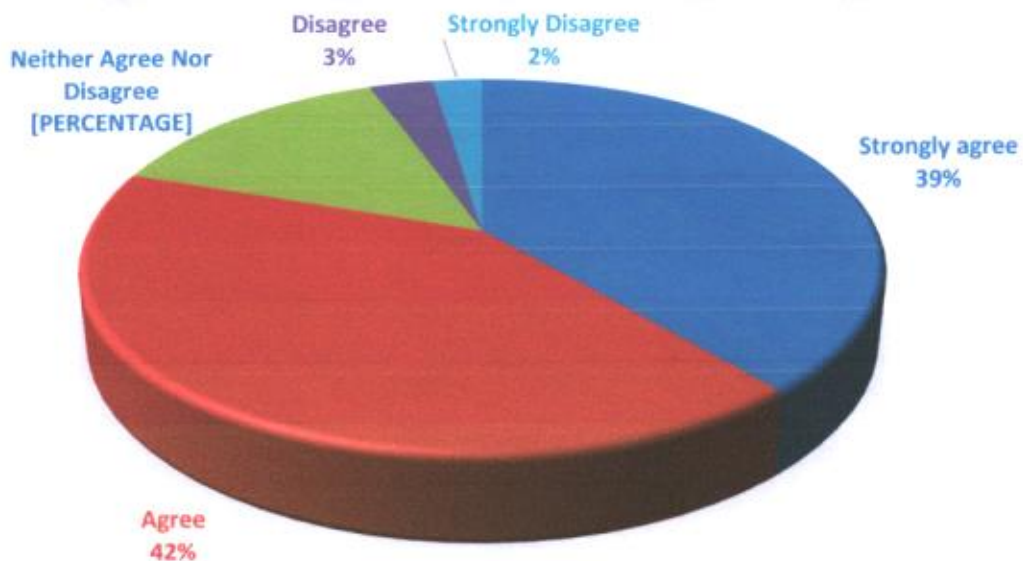
Feedback 8: The college maintains strict adherence to the academic calendar

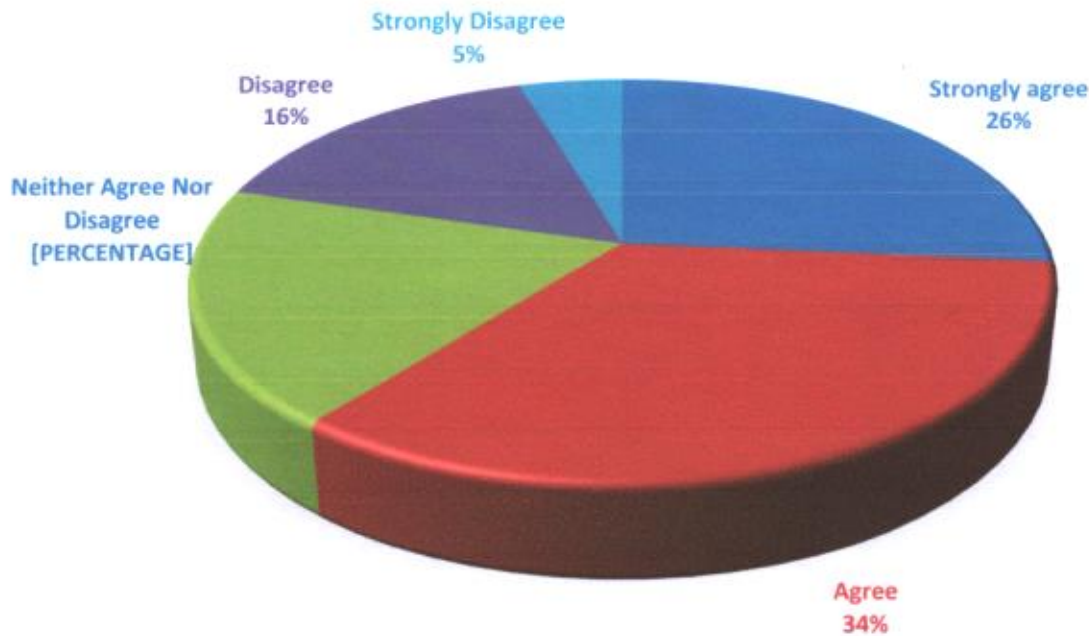
Feedback 9: The infrastructure facilities for teaching and research are excellent

Feedback Analysis

The parents opinions related to the programme offered in the college is collected using printed questionnaires. Six Hundred and Twenty one parents participated in the process. The feedback from the parents is collected by eliciting their responses on 10 statements related to-

1. Prospects of the Programme
2. Regular updation of the courses and contents
3. Quality of Faculty
4. Examination and Evaluation System
5. Adherence to the Academic Calendar
6. Infrastructure

7. Provisions for Extra-curricular activities

A remarkable majority (of 82 %) favours that the programmes in FATIMA offer life skills and employability. 80 per cent of the parents participated thinks that the programmes in FATIMA equipped their wards in qualifying different competitive examinations. 86 per cent of parents believe that graduates from Fatima are getting progressed to higher studies. So in total, as per the feedback, the programmes in FATIMA are prospecting with regard to employability and higher education.

The agreement to the regular updation of syllabus is 82 per cent which shows parents' confidence in the academic system.

Ninety per cent of respondents think that the faculty members are competent and knowledgeable and 74 are of the opinion that college provides special assistance to slow and advanced learners. A majority at 90 per cent stated that the examination and evaluation system at FATIMA is transparent and fair.

Regarding the scheduling and implementation, 88 per cent of the parents participated in the feedback survey are sure that FATIMA strictly adheres to the academic calendar.

The infrastructure facilities at FATIMA is satisfactory to 81 per cent parents, but 19 per cent of them take neutral and negative stand, that has to be taken care off.

Regarding the provision for extra-curricular activities, 61 per cent believe it is satisfactory. But the neutral stand at 19 per cent and negative stand at 20 per cent have to be addressed.

Conclusions

The report is submitted to the IQAC, Heads of the Departments, Deans of Faculties, BoS Chairmen, and the College Council.
