


Feedback 1: The aims and objectives of the curriculum are well defined and clear to the students


Feedback 2: The curriculum gives emphasis on the overall development of the students helping them develop a comprehensive outlook






Feedback 5: The curriculum helps to enhance the interests of the students and motivates them to pursue higher studies


Feedback 6: The tests and examinations are conducted well in time and the results are published on time


Feedback 7: The curriculum is on par with the syllabi offered by the reputed universities and centres of excellence


Feedback 8: The college conducts PTA meetings regularly ensuring productive interaction with the teaching faculty


Feedback 9: The interaction with the administrative staff is satisfactory


Feedback 10: The weak students are identified and Remedial classes are given before the End Semester Exams

Feedback Analysis

The feedback from the parents was collected by eliciting their responses on 11 statements related to Course and Curriculum, Infrastructure, Scheduling of Tests and Examinations, Interaction with Teachers and Administrative Staff, Provision for Remedial classes and extra-curricular activities.

The statements 1,2,3,5 and 7 are related to the curricular aspects. In all these cases positive responses to each of the statements clearly illustrate the effectiveness of the syllabus and curriculum followed in the College.

99 per cent of the parents were satisfied with the existing infrstructure at FMNC, adequate for the effective teaching-learning transactions.

All the parents who participated in the feedback survey unanimously expressed the view that the examinations, evaluation and publication of results are time bound. The same response was evident at the Parent Teacher meetings also.

One area that appears to need more attention is the level of interaction with the administrative staff. Only 55 per cent of the parents expressed satisfaction over the interpersonal skills of the administrative staff, while 32 per cent on the neutral side and 13 per cent on the negative side.

The parents were appreciative of the remedial classes, with 80 per cent acknowledging that FMNC arrange remedial classes for weak learners.

73 per cent of the parents were of the opinion that the extra-curricular activities at the College are satisfactory.

Conclusion

The report is submitted to the IQAC, Heads of the Departments, Deans of Faculties, Chairmen of the BOS, and the College Council.
