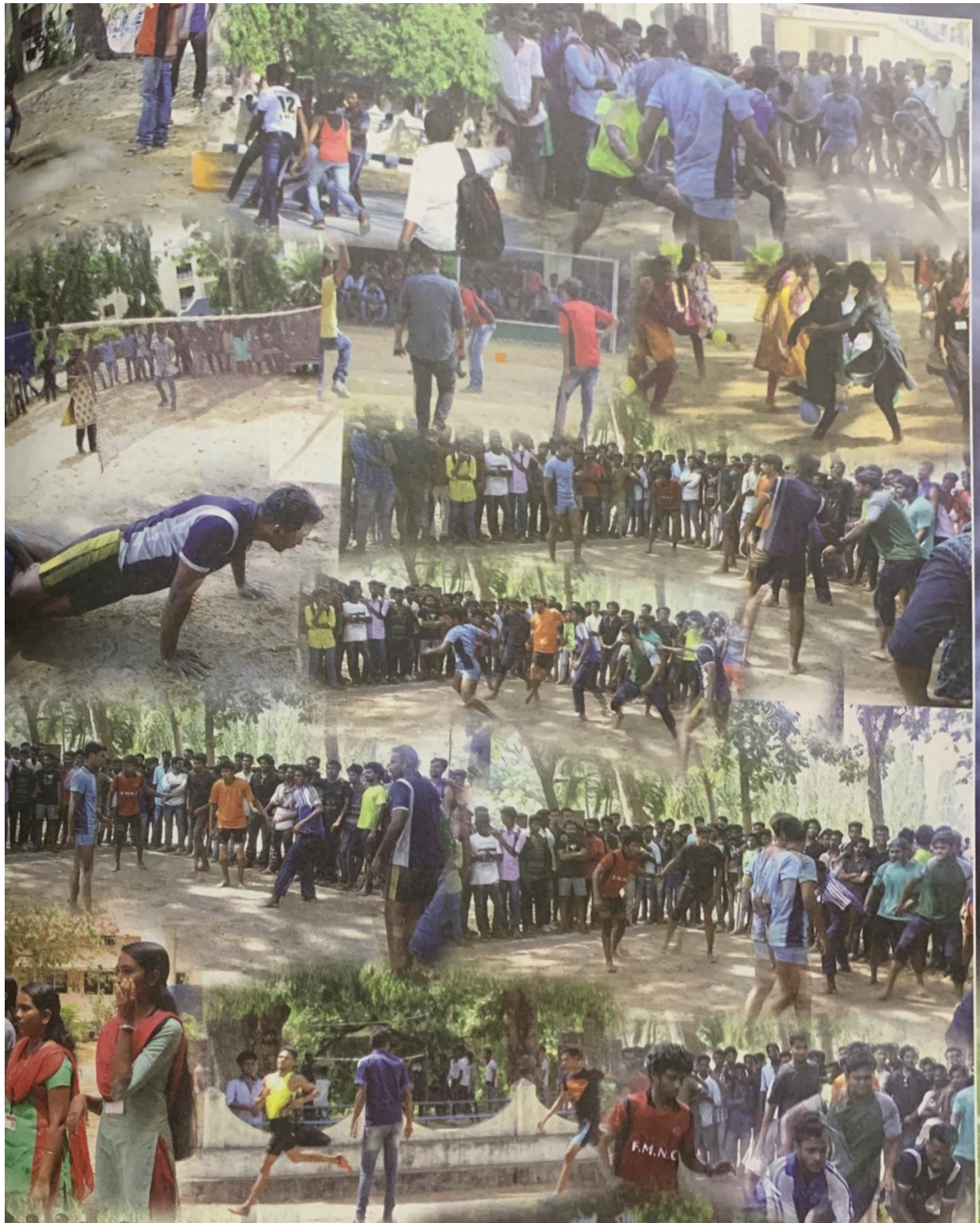

WOMENS' DAY CELEBRATION

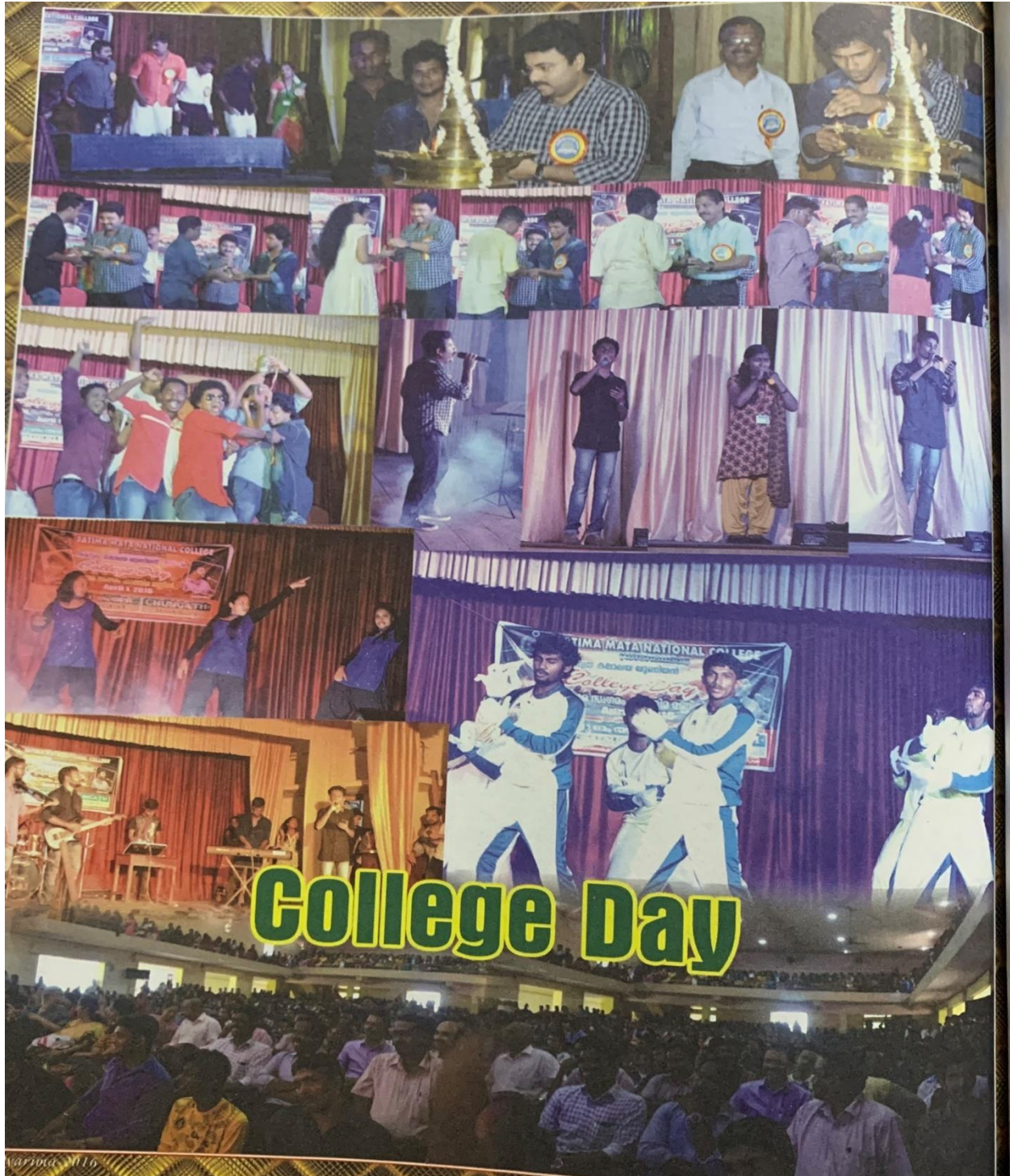
