Dowry Prohibition ACT – 1961



This Act prohibits the practice of giving or taking of dowry. This law also punishes demanding and advertising dowry. The dowry system is thought to put great financial burden on the bride's family. In some cases, the dowry system leads to crime against women, ranging from emotional abuse and injury to even deaths. The payment of dowry has long been prohibited under specific Indian laws including the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and subsequently by Sections 304B and 498A of the Indian Penal Code.
